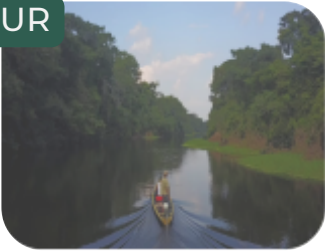


TARAPOTO LAKES BOAT TOUR

Duration: 4 hours
Suggested departure: 08:00 AM or 03:00 PM
Difficulty: Easy
Develope: Boat trip/ Wild dolphins watching / floodable forest / Snack / Swimming



We will pick you up from your hotel in Puerto Nariño and begin a scenic boat trip through the spectacular Tarapoto Lakes Wetland System, a protected Ramsar biodiversity reserve. We will navigate along the Loretoyacu River before entering the flooded forest surrounding the lakes. This ecosystem is home to an extraordinary variety of wildlife including: Pink river dolphins, Caimans, Birds and aquatic wildlife, Anacondas and other reptiles. If we are lucky, we may observe some of these animals during the journey. Once we reach the main lake, we will stop to enjoy a traditional snack and take a refreshing swim in the calm waters of the Amazon wetlands. After approximately four hours exploring the reserve, we return to Puerto Nariño.

NIGHT JUNGLE HIKE

Duration: 2.5 hours
Departure: 6:00 PM
Difficulty: Moderate
Develope: Jungle Trekking - Fauna Watching
Tools: Ruber boots (included) and Flashlight



An indigenous hunter guide will meet you at your hotel in Puerto Nariño and provide rubber boots and rain protection before entering the rainforest. Once the sun sets, the jungle becomes incredibly active. During this guided night hike, you will explore the Amazon forest searching for nocturnal wildlife like Frogs and amphibians , Tarantulas and spiders , Nocturnal birds . Snakes and reptiles
Walking quietly through the jungle, you will experience the fascinating sounds and atmosphere of the Amazon at night. The tour finishes around 8:30 PM, when we return to your hotel.

Develope: Boat - Hiking or canoeing (depends on weather) / lunch /



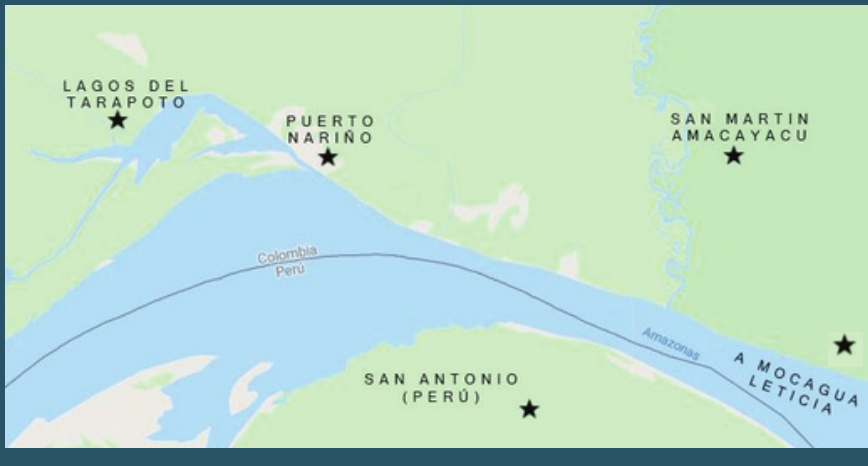
This excursion takes you across the Amazon River to Cacao Island in Peru, famous for its flooded forests, wildlife, and traditional cuisine. After a short boat ride from Puerto Nariño, we arrive at the San Antonio community, where you will learn about the daily life and traditions of the local residents.

- Trail Amazon trees: The adventure continues with a guided jungle walk through the island’s rainforest. During the hike you will discover: Giant ceiba trees , Medicinal plants, Flooded forest ecosystems
- Trail Sloths: resting in the trees

After exploring the jungle, we return to Puerto Nariño by boat.

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AMACAYACU INDIGENOUS COMMUNITY TREK

Duration: 7 hours
Departure: 9:00 AM
Difficulty: Moderate

This adventure begins with a jungle trek along the ecological trail leading into Amacayacu National Natural Park. During the hike you will walk through one of the most biodiverse regions of the Amazon rainforest, crossing elevated wooden pathways and observing unique flora and fauna.
The route ends in a Tikuna indigenous community, where visitors will enjoy a traditional Amazonian lunch and learn about indigenous culture and sustainable forest practices.
After lunch, we return to Puerto Nariño by boat along the Amazon River.

Travel along the Amazon River to the indigenous community of Mocagua, where we will visit the Maikuchiga Monkey Sanctuary. This conservation project rescues and rehabilitates primates that have been victims of illegal wildlife trafficking. During the visit you will: Learn about Amazon primate species Understand conservation efforts Walk through rainforest trails Observe monkeys in rehabilitation areas After the visit, we return to the community for a traditional Amazonian lunch, before heading back to Puerto Nariño by boat.
